# **Strategic errors of the West**

- 2014-2022: multiple hybrid attacks on Europe: "existential threats" (EU 2016)
- Art 5 not credible (RAND 2016)
- Bad assessment of mindset of authoritarian regimes
- Excluding military support made Putin's strategic considerations easier
- Deep divisions among European states
- Economics trumped security considerations
- Putin deterred the West, or was it self-deterrence?

At riss was bound to happen. Vladimir Putin's war on Chechnya did not serve as a wake-up call for the West in 1999. Neither did the Kremlin's cyber-assault on Estonia in 2007, its war on Georgia in 2008, the illegal annexation of Crimea, nor the start of its milliary aggression against Ukraine in 2014–2011 of which Russia denies. Numerous, blatant assassinations of "inconvenient" witnesses, opponents and journalists ang alarm bells, especially when carried out on European soil. But Western Reders pressed the snoze buttor time and again.







# **Putin nearly succeeded**

- 10-day war plan: focus = Kyiv
- Speed of maneuver
- Too fast for timely western response
- Decapitate pol & mil leadership
- Defeat Ukrainian military



## **Putin's Strategic Errors**

- Underestimated speed of Western coordinated multidimensional response
  - Unprecedented sanctions regime
  - Increasing Western military support
- Gambled on early Blitzkrieg style coup of Kyiv
- Overestimated own military capabilities
  - Flawed combined arms operations
  - Fails to achieve air superiority
- No preparations for long war
- 4-front war with low troop density
- Underestimated Ukraine

# Effective Ukrainian defence

- Strategy is not to lose, gain time, impose costs on RU
- Avoid decisive armored battles in open terrain
- Inundation, Urban defence & woods favor defender
- Mobile battalions & Spec Ops teams
  - "roaming interior lines", dispersed, negate clear frontline
  - Hit & run strikes against convoys, focus on SSV, fuel trucks,
- Use of drones, AT, Stingers, SA-300, Migs, Massive art'y
- Zelensky unifies the nation and the West

### April 9: Retreat from Kyiv, end of "special operation"

- Massive losses: week 1 2000 casualties, 88 fighters/heli
- towards 2 front attrition war
- Slow expansion of south & eastern controlled areas
- RU brings in reinforcements, slow going
  - Conscripts untrained, not combat ready
  - Logistical & C2 challenges
- South: horrific Grozny-type siege tactics & urban warfare
- Massive civilian casualties: Bucha, Irpin, Mariupol
- Intense air & missile attacks on civil society
